### Financial Arrangements

#### Pastorial Discount:

In an effort to enhance the valued partnership with our Bible churches, CCCS offers full time Pastors the opportunity to receive tuition assistance discount off their families' full tuition.

#### Non-sufficient Funds (NSF):

\$25 per check or direct debit not honored by the bank.

#### Late Fee:

\$25 per month may be assessed for any family whose tuition not current at the end of the month.

#### Delinquent Accounts:

Students whose tuition is more than ninety days in arrears will be withdrawn.

## FACTS Tuition Management

### How Tuition Is Paid

CCCS utilizes FACTS Tuition Management, which automatically debits your payments from your bank account once a month using the payment method that each family chooses. Families who choose to pay in full prior to the start of the school year do not have to enroll in FACTS. You can enroll in FACTS by going to <https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/4JR4T>. Once you enroll in FACTS, you will be automatically re-enrolled in FACTS for the following school year.

**There are four methods available for tuition payment:**

- 1) **Annual Payment:** Checks will be accepted for tuition that is fully paid prior to July 1.
- 2) **Semi-Annual Payments:** 2 Payments.
- 3) **Monthly Payments:** 12 Payments.
- 4) **Bi-Monthly Payment Plan:** 24 Payments.

Payments must be paid through the school's designated online tuition management service (FACTS Tuition Management Service) via a preauthorized monthly checking or savings account debit deduction or credit card charge. Payments begin in July and continue through June.

**(Please note, payments made through a credit card are assessed an additional charge for processing fees.)**

## Scholarship Information

Our EITC Scholarship Fund was established to assist qualifying families who have sacrificed to make education a priority in their family. The fund is financed through contributions from generous donors and the Educational Improvement Tax Credit Program. The EITC Scholarship is applicable only to tuition costs and is not extended to other charges such as registration fees.

Columbia County Christian School utilizes an independent service called FACTS Grant and Aid Assessment. Based on the information submitted in the FACTS Grant and Aid application, FACTS provides the school with an independent assessment of a family's eligibility for the EITC Scholarship.

**To apply for the EITC Scholarship, please follow the steps outlined below.** If you need additional information, please contact the Business Manager, Robert Gennaria at 570-784-2977.

1. **Complete the confidential FACTS Tuition Assistance Application online through your FACTS account.**
2. **Send in any supporting documentation requested by FACTS by the date required.** No tuition assistance can be awarded without these documents.

### **3. You will be Notified of EITC Scholarship Award.**

(Please note that completion of the online application does not guarantee a tuition assistance award.)
